




Mysterium Cosmographicum (1596)




Kepler's Three Laws of Planetary Motion



The orbits are ellipses




Equal areas in equal time





$T^2 \propto a^3$ T = time to complete orbit
 a = semi-major axis




Exoplanet detection: (Radial Velocity Method)




